



4 Week Hair Styling Course for the Sessional Make up Artiste

This course offers intensive training in all skills relevant for hairdressing for the Film TV and Photographic industry.

Media hairdressing is not to be confused with salon hairdressing.

As a make up artist it is always advantageous to have this essential skill hair and make-up go hand in hand.

More and more the jobs out there are asking for hair and make up artist's to be able to offer the full package, so only offering make up you could be losing work.

This course will take you from basic hair techniques, through creative fashion looks, styling and dressing hair for the camera, through to fantasy/futuristic creations, to wig work and period hair designs. You will leave this course with the confidence and skills to achieve any style desired.

Course content:

Week 1 & 2

Introduction

Tools, equipment & products, Health & safety

Using heated appliances (hairdryers, heated rollers, tongs, bendy curlers, crimpers straightening irons, conical wand)

Setting hair wet & dry (using heated rollers, bendy curlers velcro, conventional rollers)

Understand working with different hair types and conditions: Fine, thick, curly, Asian, Afro Caribbean, Caucasian, (dry, damaged, greasy, treated & extensions) Problem hair (alopecia, dandruff, psoriasis, lice)

Styling hair for Theatre, photography, TV & Film, Creating different simple fashion looks to brief:

Casual, day time, evening, classic, high fashion, contemporary, business.

Short hair styling (male & female) young and mature styles, different ages

Maintaining styles on set and quick changes, Hair continuity

Long hair work Barrel curls Buns, smooth & mess Chignons under & over, using hair pads and hair piece, Catwalk hair (3 looks) Beehives. High fashion styles, Current trends, Hair accessories

Week 3 & 4

Wigs, hair piece & switch work

Measuring for a wig & sizing

Tools, equipment & products

Blocking wigs and cleaning, repairs & problems

Applying and fitting lace edge wigs.

Wrapping hair, wig application, removal, care, setting & dressing

Understanding period dressing i.e. Elizabethan, 1920s etc..

Apply facial hair i.e. moustaches & beards

Switches work & cluster pieces

Cage making & padding

Toupees
